Assistance dog task work

Assistance dogs can help mitigate the impact of disability by being trained to perform various tasks, including...

- Retrieval
- DPT (Deep Pressure Therapy)
- Interrupters
- Removal of clothes (socks, gloves, tops etc.)
- Rest
- Over
- Unload and load washing machine
- Open/Close doors
- Block
- Crowd Control (Round)
- Buttons/Switches/Traffic light crossings
- Wheelchair assistance i.e. foot plates
- Medical Aids (meds, crutches etc.)
- Medical Response
- Load – shopping, bins, washing machine, cupboards
- Guiding – Exit, Chair
- Alert emergency contact
- Settle/support
- Bespoke training for individual needs
